	Foreign Nationals	Thai Nationals Returning to Thailand
Upon Check-in	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Verify passengers' travel history in the last 14 days before the date of travel 2. Require the presentation of; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Health certificate certifying that the passengers "pose no risk of being infected by the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19)", issued no more than 72 hours prior to the date of travel. (2) Health insurance/health insurance policy that shows minimum medical coverage of 100,000 USD in Thailand and covers the Covid-19 Disease <p>Note: If the passenger has traveled to Disease Infected Zones or Ongoing Local Transmission Areas, or is unable to present the required documents in 2 or 3, the air operator shall not issue a boarding pass and the boarding shall be denied.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Require the presentation of "Fit to Fly" health certificate 2. Certifying Letter from Royal Thai Embassy, Thai Consulate Office or Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Kingdom of Thailand <p>Note: If the passenger is unable to present the required documents in 1 or 2, the air operator shall not issue a boarding pass and the boarding shall be denied.</p>
Upon Receiving Boarding Pass	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Arrange seats to passengers with the greatest possible distance apart from each other when issuing boarding passes 2. Arrange for passengers to provide information on the address in Thailand in the T.8 Form 	
On Board	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Inform passengers on how to protect themselves from communicable diseases 2. Limit services in the passenger cabin 3. Require all flight attendants to wear masks 	
Entry to Thailand (Passenger's Duty)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Present the T.8 Form to the communicable disease control official 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Present the T.8 Form to the communicable disease control official 2. 14 days self-quarantine at their own residence
